We are looking forward to welcoming you in Kiel to another international surgical Wilson's workshop: Surgical Course, Cadaver and Live Surgical Workshop on penile implants. This is already the 4<sup>th</sup> surgical course, with growing recognition due to the unique comprehensive cooperation between clinical anatomy and surgical andrology.

We feel lucky that we have been able yet again to engage Prof. SK Wilson, a renowned expert in the field of implant surgery from California, U.S.. For example, a new way of high submuscular reservoir placement, this technique got FDA approval this year.
