



COLLIN-Conference- 29th August 2013 in Kiel



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COLLIN – COLLABoration for INnovation – is a common project of the university hospitals Kiel (UKSH) and Odense (OUH) to promote clinical innovation in both hospitals and to build up a cross-border network for knowledge transfer and projects in healthcare innovations.

The path for COLLIN has been paved in the preceding ROBIN Project. This project under the lead partnership of OUH (2010-2012) brought together the two University Hospitals for the first time in a collaboration integrating various areas and departments on the topic of healthcare robotics. The ROBIN activities revealed the large scope of robotic innovation projects in Southern Denmark which contrasted with a relative lack of such activities in the German Interreg Region. Moreover, it became clear that the University Hospitals on both sides of the border require up-to-date processes and technologies in many different areas, ranging from hospital transport and warehousing via lab automation down to robot-assisted surgery, patient care and e-Health solutions. COLLIN sets out to help close this gap and to take “collaboration for innovation” further.

On 29th August 2013 there will be the first COLLIN-Conference in Kiel. We are very happy that we have been given the opportunity to present this conference on the premises of the Kieler Landeshaus.

We aim to bring together clinicians, leading hospital employees, researchers and people from politics and public institutions dealing with regional healthcare to provide a glimpse of the added value that cross-border collaboration in the field of clinical innovation can provide.

We are looking forward to seeing you in Kiel at the Landeshaus.

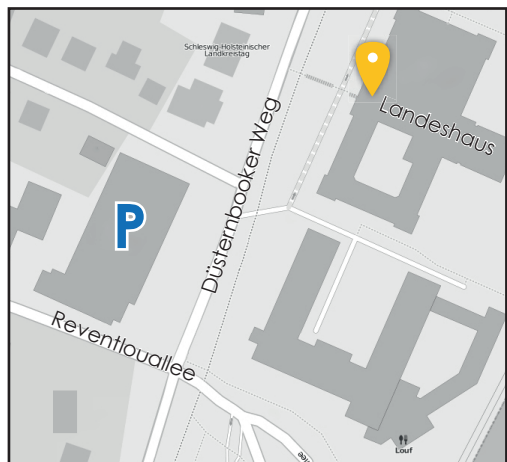
